WAITARA PONY CLUB Rules for use of Arena and Grounds

All riders and horses enter and use the arena and grounds at their own risk. Approved helmets must be worn when mounted and appropriate footwear. Back protectors must be worn when using the cross country jumps. Pony Club rallies and events organised or sanctioned by the Pony Club have priority over private users. If a rider arrives to find the

grounds are in use for the above they must wait until the grounds are free before using. Any person riding on the cross country areas must be considerate of the stock grazing and must stay out of paddocks where horses/ponies are grazing. All horses must be under full control at all times, there is to be no 'loose schooling' in the arena. All equipment must be used in a responsible manner with the welfare of the horse/pony in mind and not in such a manner as is likely to cause damage to the equipment. You must notify a WPC member of any damages, depending on what is damaged you may be liable for the cost associated with fixing the item. Please pick up all horse manure (from the sand arena, yards and parking paddock) and place in the bins provided. Please take your rubbish with you. Please park your trucks and floats in the parking paddock and not the sealed area outside the club rooms. Riders under the age of 18 years must be supervised by a parent or guardian over the age of 18 years. Please ensure you shut and padlock any gates you open. Any person using the grounds, must be either a key holder or have paid the \$10 casual rider fee and they must sign the policies and procedures agreement prior to riding. If a person loses a key, there will be a \$50 replacement fee. Only the people listed below are permitted to ride on the grounds and have access to your key. (If you pass your key onto anyone else, you will forfeit your rights to be a key holder.)

I/we agree to abide by all rules as set above whilst riding on WPC grounds and acknowledge that failure to abide by these rules will result in the cancellation of this contract. WPC committee reserves the right to add to or change the rules as they see fit. Applications will be considered on an individual basis.
